

RESOLUTION providing for and requiring the submission of a public question regarding a limiting rate increase to the voters of Rockdale School District 84, Will County, Illinois, at the general election to be held on the 6th day of November 2018.

WHEREAS, the Board of Education (the "School Board") of Rockdale School District 84, Will County, Illinois (the "School District"), is maintaining and operating a system of schools for grades Kindergarten through 8, inclusive; and

WHEREAS, for the 2017 levy year, the School Board was authorized to levy taxes for all operating funds up to the limiting rate of 1.3735% upon all the taxable property of the School District at the value as equalized or assessed by the Department of Revenue of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the School Board does hereby find and determine that the existing limiting rate for operating purposes is not sufficient to provide funds to pay the costs of providing an efficient and adequate program to meet the needs of the School District and it is hereby found and determined by the School Board that the need exists for increasing the present limiting rate of the School District for any purpose of the School District, and establishing the same at 2.2735% upon all the taxable property of the School District for the levy year 2018 at the value as equalized or assessed by the Department of Revenue; and

WHEREAS, before the School Board is authorized to levy taxes at the increased limiting rate of 2.2735%, the proposition of increasing said limiting rate and establishing the same at said 2.2735% must be submitted to the voters of the School District as provided by the provisions of the *Property Tax Extension Limitation Law*, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, and such proposition must be approved by a majority of the voters of the School District voting on such proposition at an election to be held in and for the School District, and it is hereby

deemed advisable, necessary and in the best interests of the School District that the proposition of increasing said limiting rate and establishing the same at the rate of 2.2735% for the levy year 2018 for any purpose of the School District, be submitted to the voters of the District at an election to be held and conducted in accordance with the general election law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of Rockdale School District 84, Will County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution.

Section 2. That it is necessary and in the best interests of the School District, in order that the School District may maintain and operate an efficient system of schools within the School District, that the present limiting rate of the School District for any purpose of the School District be increased to 2.2735% upon all the taxable property of the School District for the levy year 2018 at the value, as equalized or assessed by the Department of Revenue.

Section 3. That the public question, hereinabove referred to, be submitted to the voters of the School District in accordance with the general election law at the general election to be held on Tuesday, the 6th day of November, 2018, between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on said day (the "Election").

Section 4. That the Election shall be held in the voting precincts and at the polling places established by the County Board of the County of Will, Illinois (the "County"), for voters of the School District at said election.

Section 5. That the County Clerk of the County (the "County Clerk") shall give notice of the Election, including the Spanish translation thereof, (the "Notice") in accordance with the general election law by (i) publishing the Notice thereof once, not more than 30 nor less

than 10 days prior to the date of the Election, in a local, community newspaper having general circulation in the School District, and (ii) posting a copy of the Notice at least 10 days before the date of the Election at the principal office of the County Clerk.

Section 6. That the Secretary of the School Board shall also post a copy of the Notice at the principal office of the School Board.

Section 7. That it is hereby found and determined that the *Herald-News* is a local, community newspaper having general circulation in the School District, all as required by Section 12-5 of the *Election Code* of the State of Illinois, as amended.

Section 8. That said Notice required by Sections 5 and 6, herein, shall include the following:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at the general election to be held on Tuesday, the 6th day of November, 2018, the following proposition will be submitted to the voters of Rockdale School District 84, Will County, Illinois:

Shall the limiting rate under the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law for Rockdale School District 84, Will County, Illinois, be increased by an additional amount equal to .90% above the limiting rate for school purposes of said School District for levy year 2017 and be equal to 2.2735% of the equalized assessed value of the taxable property therein for levy year 2018?

- (1) The approximate amount of taxes extendable at the most recently extended limiting rate is \$1,094,440 and the approximate amount of taxes extendable if the proposition is approved is \$1,811.583.
- (2) For the 2018 levy year the approximate amount of the additional tax extendable against property containing a single-family residence and having a fair market value at the time of the referendum of \$100,000 is estimated to be \$299.70.¶
- (3) If the proposition is approved, the aggregate extension for 2018 will be determined by the limiting rate set forth in the proposition, rather than the otherwise applicable limiting rate calculated under the provisions of the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law (commonly known as the Property Tax Cap Law).

The polls at said election will be open from 6:00 o'clock a.m. and continued open until 7:00 o'clock p.m. of that day.


Section 10. That the Election shall be conducted by the election judges appointed by the County Board to act in the precincts at which said public question will be submitted to the voters of the School District.

That after the adoption hereof and not less than 79 days prior to the date of the Election, the Secretary of the School Board shall certify a copy hereof to the County Clerk in order that the public question set forth herein may be submitted to the voters of the School District at the Election.


Section 12. That the Election shall be held and conducted, and the returns thereof duly canvassed, all in the manner and time as provided by the general election law.
