



## **Rockdale School District 84 Remote Learning Plan 2019-2020 School Year**

Remote Learning days are intended to provide access to learning on days when physical attendance is prohibited. Various online recommended Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) and staff activities will be offered to students on days that are classified as remote learning days. While these days cannot replace the face-to-face time students have with their teachers, it can provide opportunities for learning while school is cancelled.

ISBE guidelines will serve as a guide in all decisions to the extent the District is able to comply. Students will be given learning packets at the primary grade levels, while students at the intermediate and middle school level will have access to online instruction. All students will be provided access to school Chromebooks in order to complete instruction and interactive activities with their child's teacher. Grades will not negatively be affected during remote learning days. The state has allowed for five non-student transition days during remote learning to allow staff planning time to refine their individual remote learning plans.

Meals will be distributed each week on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. Meal distribution will take place on the west side of the building and meals will be provided to any student through 18 years of age. If a family or student is in need of help with homelessness please email the social worker.

Remote learning communication will occur using one or more of the following means:

- \* District Website
- \* Blackboard robocall notifications
- \* Teacher Ease email

During remote learning days, parents may ask questions of teachers through email using the teacher's email address. Please be sure to include your child's name in your correspondence. Staff will respond to all communication requests as soon as possible. The district appreciates the efforts of all students, parents, community members and staff as we negotiate these unprecedented and challenging times.
